Despite some chilly days, more children have been walking to school than at the beginning of Term 2. The numbers have jumped by 28% from week one and are far higher than usual!!

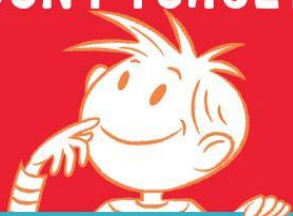
